TENDER NOTICE

It is notified for the information of general public that tenders are invited for grant of remaining sixteen retailsale country liquor (L-14A) licences in U.T. Chandigarh for remaining period of twelve months, commencing from 1st May, 2011 to 30th April, 2012, as below: -

(i) Tenders shall be submitted separately for each retailsale licence. The bidder will be required to furnish bid only in the prescribed format (with a passport size photograph) individually and separately for each vend/licence. A bidder can apply for any number of vends/licences, however each bidder will be allowed to submit only one bid for a particular vend. In case multiple tenders are submitted by a tenderer for a particular vend, all his bids will be liable for rejection/cancellation. The category wise detailed list mentioning localities/sectors of remaining retailsale country liquor (L-14A) licences and financial bid proforma can be obtained from the O/o Asstt. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Additional Town Hall Building, Sector 17, Chandigarh on any working day during office hours i.e. from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM or can be downloaded from the Chandigarh Administration's website www.chandigarh.gov.in from **What's New** section.

(ii) The basic quota of each retailsale country liquor (L-14A) licence is fixed at 41,538.461 proof litres. Each retailsale country liquor licensee will be allowed to lift additional quota upto maximum of 60% of the basic quota, by paying Rs.3/- per proof litre, as additional licence fee. In case of non lifting of basic quota, by L-14A licensee, the licensee will be required to pay Excise Duty @ Rs. 7 per proof litre on unlifted quota.

(iii) The category wise reserve price for remaining retailsale country liquor (L-14A) licences is as under: -

Category	Reserve Price
Retailsale Country Liquor (L-14A) licence in pre-fabricated temporary structure	Rs. 37 Lacs
Retailsale Country Liquor (L-14A) licence in SCO/SCF/Shop/Booth etc	Rs. 32 Lacs

(iv) Each tenderer will be required to submit pay order/demand draft in favour of Asstt. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, U.T. Chandigarh of Rs.25,000/- as participation fee with each tender at the time of submission of tender, which will be non-refundable & non-adjustable.

(v) Each tenderer will be required to furnish pay order/demand draft in favour of Asstt. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, U.T. Chandigarh of 25% of the reserve price as earnest money. The successful tenderer will be further required to deposit 35% of bid amount within seven days from the date of finalizing the tenders **i.e. by 10th June 2011** or before the grant of licence, whichever is earlier. The earnest money paid with the application/tender document will be adjustable in initial 35% amount of licence fee. However, in case a successful bidder/tenderer fails to pay 35% of bid amount by **10th June, 2011**, the earnest money paid by him/her with tender document will stand forfeited. Such licence will be offered again by inviting fresh tenders.

(vi) In case of individuals or partnership firms, the tenderer will be required to submit age proof, copy of PAN of self or of all partners of a partnership firm/partnership firm and eligibility affidavit under order 7 of Punjab Intoxicants Licence & Sales Orders, 1956 (as applicable to U.T. Chandigarh) along-with the tender document containing bid.

(vii) In case of companies, the tenderer will be required to submit Registration Certificate issued by the Registrar of Companies under the Companies Act, 1956, a copy of PAN in the name of company, list of Board of Directors, a resolution passed by the Board of Directors authorizing any person to apply on behalf of the company and eligibility affidavit under order 7 of Punjab Intoxicants Licence & Sales Orders, 1956 (as applicable to U.T. Chandigarh) along-with the tender document containing bid.

(viii) The tender document containing bid amount shall be signed by an individual or by all partners of a partnership firm or by authorized person on behalf of a company, as the case may be.

(ix) Participation Fee & Earnest Money along-with requisite documents shall be submitted by the tenderer in an open envelope marked "Technical Bid". The financial bid quoting the bid amount shall be sealed by the tenderer in a separate envelope marked "Financial Bid". Both these envelopes shall be marked "TENDER FOR

RETAILSALE FOREIGN LIQUOR OR COUNTRY LIQUOR LICENCE” by clearly mentioning the name of the licence applied for with code, category & sector/locality as mentioned in the public notice. The same should reach the office of Asstt. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Sector 17, Chandigarh **on or before 3:00 PM of 3rd June, 2011.**

(x) The sealed bids shall be put into the duly sealed box by the bidder himself/herself or their representative.

(xi) The licence will be allotted to the highest eligible tenderer (offering highest bid), quoting bid equal to or above the reserve price for a particular licence/vend. In case, more than one bid quoting the same highest price are received, the successful tenderer/bidder will be determined by a draw of lots amongst the tenderers quoting the same highest amount. However, the licences will be granted only to those successful tenderers/allottees, who have the spaces in their possession & control, where they can start the liquor vend.

(xii) All the tenders received upto the last prescribed date & time, containing financial bids will be opened in the presence of tenderers, who wish to be present, by the committee comprising of Collector (Excise) & a Sub-Divisional Magistrate. The allotment will take place at the O/o Asstt. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Sector 17, U.T. Chandigarh **on 3rd June, 2011 from 4:00 PM onwards.**

(xiii) List of vend wise bidders will be displayed in the O/o Asstt. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Union Territory, Chandigarh after the closing time fixed for receipt of tenders.

(xiv) The successful tenderer will be solely & fully responsible for arrangement/possession of premises for operating a liquor vend. The Department will have no responsibility, whatsoever, in case a successful tenderer fails to make an arrangement for a premises. Similarly, the Department will not be responsible for providing land for pre-fabricated temporary structures. The successful allottees in respect of pre-fabricated temporary structures categories, will have to execute rent deed with or obtain No Objection Certificate from land owning agency/owner, which will be the sole responsibility of the successful allottee. However, the licences will be

granted only to those successful tenderers/allottees, who have the spaces in their possession & control, where they can start the liquor vend.

(xv)The licenses shall be granted by the Collector (Excise) after the approval of the Excise & Taxation Commissioner, U.T. Chandigarh.

(xvi)All licenses, whether for wholesale or for retail sale, shall be granted subject to the provisions of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and the Rules/ Orders/Regulations/ Instructions/Policies framed there under from time to time as applicable to U.T. Chandigarh

(xvii) No interest will be payable on the earnest amount.

(xviii) Tenders will be received in the O/o Asstt. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Union Territory, Chandigarh on any working day till 03:00 PM of 3rd June, 2011

(xix) The detailed information regarding vend code of remaining licences, reserve price, excise duties & levies, etc. can be obtained from the O/o. Asstt. Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Additional Town Hall Building, Sector 17, U.T. Chandigarh on any working day during office hours i.e. from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM or can be downloaded from Chandigarh Administration's website www.chandigarh.gov.in from What's New section.
